Abstracts

To encourage people to contribute maximum papers, three presentations per person are allowed for the first author, and one may be coauthor of unlimited number of contributions presented by others. Length of each abstract prepared for publication is limited to two standard printed pages (A4), including figures, tables, references. Authors from the former USSR countries must send abstracts both in Russian and in English, others - only in English. You are welcomed to send abstracts via email in UUENCODE form. Abstracts must be sent before 15th May 1997.

Travel and accommodation

For the participants from the "West" countries, travel to the place of the conference is supposed to be organized from Moscow by train. The one-way ticket Moscow-Cheboksary is about 200,000 rubles or 40 USD (1996). The train tickets may be aslo reserved for the participants from the former USSR.
