## Current techniques in the alpine ecological research II.

After the establishment of the first "Alpine ecological research" meeting in the High Tatras, we tend to continue in our effort to bring together specialists from around the world to address state of the current ecological methods in the high altitude areas.

The meeting and the meeting tours will be held over four days, August 27 through 30, 1995, and will be held at the Felicia Hotel in Stará Lesná in the High Tatras region, Slovakia. This hotel is a good quality and low-rise hotel with outside forest area, and is away from the downtown areas, within 10 miles of the Poprad Airport.

Please note that the lecture days and excursion days may be exchanged in dependence on weather conditions.

Post-conference tours will be available on special request. Payment for these post-conference excursions will be specified the day before the route, and will depend on selected subject and type of route.

#### Papers

Persons who want to present lectures or posters should submit a manuscript of the paper for publication in the special volume of *Oecologia Montana*. The articles may be in a form of "Techniques and strategies", "Reports", but we prefer "Standart articles". "Instructions for authors" will be sent on request. Two copies of the manuscripts should be submitted to the Editors, and an additional copy on diskette in any of available text editors is needed. Diskettes must be PC compatible (no Macintosh).

# Deadline for receipt of articles is by 29 February 1996.

The articles will be standartly reviewed, and if accepted, they will be send to the participants for check in the form of proofs. The proofs will be send to the authors, by 26 April 1996, the latest date. The corrected proofs must be returned not later than three days after receipt. If possible, please use e-mail or FAX.

# Deadline for receipt of corrected proofs is 23 May 1996.

Specific volume of *Oecologia Montana* and 30 free reprints will be provided to the contributors at the registration desk.

#### Lectures and posters

Oral sessions: Oral papers will be 15 minutes plus 5 minutes for questions for a total of 20 minutes per presentation. Slide projectors and video will be available.

Poster sessions: Although the participants may prepare the posters (1 x 1 m), they may be also scheduled in the scheme of oral sessions, or, at least, they must be able to introduce and discuss their poster.

Although all sessions will be in English, large number of proposed participants from Eastern Europe will surely ensure the mutual cooperation in understanding of details.

### Conference registration and accommodations

Attendees can advance register by returning the attached "Conference Registration Form", or directly, paying the registration fee and sending the xerox copy of the confirmation of payment to the address of organizers. The suggestion of the theme of lecture may be attached.

### Advance payment, until April 1, 1996 — 4,700 Sk (Slovak crowns)

Social events, travel and transportation

Information on local tours will be available at the meeting. Prepare clothing for variable weather in high altitude area. Formal dress is not required during the meeting.

Access to Poprad is most convenient by air. The local airport Poprad - Tatry is connected by service with the international airports in Bratislava and Prague. But the flights to Wien, then by bus to Bratislava, and by train to Poprad are cheaper. There are regular train services from Prague to Poprad, from Bratislava to Poprad, and also from Russia through Ukraine, eastern Slovakia to Poprad.

The participants will be expected in the hall of railway station in the afternoon, August 26, 1996, from 2 until 6 p.m. From the airport, the regular buses connect the railway station. Stará Lesná is connected to Poprad by bus or by tram, direction to Starý Smokovec, and then to Tatranská Lomnica.
